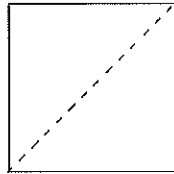


SCRAPPY UNDER CONTROL

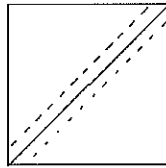
MYSTERY QUILT PART #4

For this clue you will need your 3" light/background squares and 3" dark/scrap background squares.

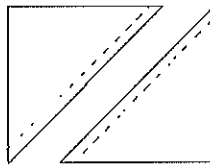
1. Draw a diagonal on the wrong side of each of the light 3" squares. If you have an Angler, you can pass this step.



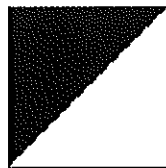
2. With right sides together place a light square on top of a 3" dark square and sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " either side of the diagonal.



3. Cut along the diagonal and press open. Press the seam allowance towards the dark fabric.



4. Make 192 bias squares each measuring $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. **IMPORTANT: You will need to square these up to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. It's worth taking the time to do this.**



5. Sew a bias square to the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " light squares.



6. Make 64 of these units which should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". The remaining half-square or bias squares will be used with the next clue.
