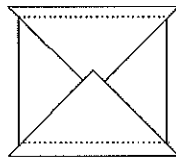


SCRAPPY UNDER CONTROL

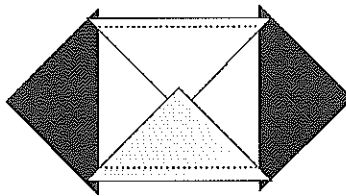
MYSTERY QUILT PART #6

Fabrics needed are the $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " light/background squares, the diagonally cut $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " dark/scrappy pieces, and the remaining units from Clue #3. Now I've told you to cut $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " light squares for the background here, but you can also use a solid color or the same color you have chosen for your inner border for that square. It will give the square a different look. It's up to you.

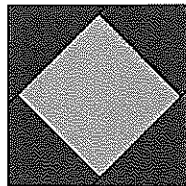
1. With right sides together sew the dark triangles to the opposite sides of the $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " light/background squares. Press the seam allowance towards the dark triangles.



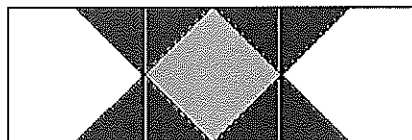
2. With right sides sew dark triangles to the remaining sides of the $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " light/background squares. Press the seam allowance towards the dark triangles.



Make 16 of these units that should measure $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " square.



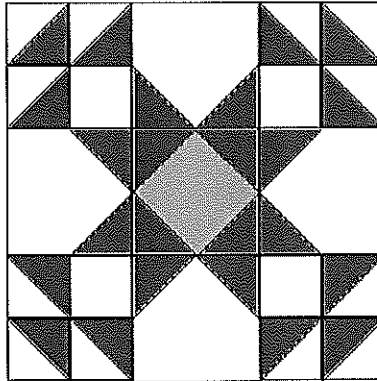
4. Join one of the remaining units constructed in Clue 3 to both sides of this unit. Pay attention to the location of the dark and light pieces. Make 16 of these units which should measure $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

4. Join the units constructed in Clue #5 to both sides of the above unit to create the following block.



5. Make 16 of these units which should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".
6. Join four of the $12\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together to form a $24\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make four of these squares.
