

Round Robin

It's time to join the new Round Robin groups that are starting in the Common Threads Quilt Guild.

It's easy!!! All you need to do is either start with a center medallion (size of your choice) or a pieced row (length of your choice). Put it in a box and turn it in to start at our November Guild meeting. The blocks are then passed on so that each person in the group will have an opportunity to work on each project.

Now for some details:

Center Medallion: Your choice in size. 18" sq. or 24" make a nice starting point; however, the choice is yours.

Row: Your choice in size. 36" pieced row works well, but again, the choice is yours.

Fabric: You may include all the fabrics that you want used in your quilt or each person may add based on your instructions.

Include either a label or journal (or both) that each person may sign. If you include a journal, tell why you made the original piece and each person can add a comment about their choices.

Be sure to include instructions in your box so the others know what you envision as a finished project (this may be at the beginning of your journal). Do you want only the fabric you provided or may others be added. What will the finished project be used for: tablecloth, wall hanging, or lap quilt? Will your quilt have a season theme or color scheme? What kind of applique' do you want used or not used in your quilt?
