

Mystery Quilt Jan-July of 2008

**Helpful if you have sticky notes and plastic bags to put your cut fabric and a box to keep your work as we unravel this mystery.

Clue # 2 - Cutting Instructions:

On this clue, we are going to cut all the fabric that we will need for the quilt top. This does not include cutting the borders. If you do not have all or none of your fabric, this will give you three (3) weeks to get it and cut it.

***** On Light and Dark fabric, you have the option to cut 2 different ways.

Light Fabric - 1). Cut 8 strips-2 7/8 " by width of fabric. Sub-cut strips into 96 squares measuring 2 7/8 "x2 7/8", then cut once on the diagonal giving you 192 half-square triangles. label and set aside **OR 2).** Cut 96 3 1/4" squares. (See Dark Fabric).

Cut 18 strips 2 1/2" by width of fabric. Put 12 strips aside. Cut the remaining 6 strips into 96 squares measuring 2 1/2"x2 1/2".

Medium Fabric # 1- Cut 9 strips 2 1/2" by width of fabric. Put 6 strips aside. Sub-cut the remaining three strips into 48 squares measuring 2 1/2"x 2 1/2".

Medium Fabric # 2-Cut 9 strips 2 1/2" by width of fabric. Put 6 strips aside. Cut remaining three strips in 48 squares, measuring 2 1/2"x2 1/2".

Dark Fabric- 1).Cut 8 strips,2 7/8" x 2 7/8" by width of fabric. Sub-cut into 96 squares measuring 2 7/8" x2 7/8", then cut once on the diagonal giving you 192 half square triangles. **OR Method 2).** Cut 96 3 1/4" squares. (Join light and dark colored 3 1/4" squares right sides together, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on light colored square, sew a quarter inch on each side of line, cut apart and square up to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
